## PRESTON LION'S JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB Terms of Agreement.

1. The name of the Club is Preston Lions Football Club.
2. The Preston Lions JFC is a subsidiary member of the Preston Lions football Club as a convenience for its members.
3. The club shall compete in such competition of the Junior Section as organized by the football federation victoria inc.trading as Preston Lions Football Club.
4. A playing member of the club shall pay the annual fee as indicated in the table below.

Payment shall be made **PRIOR TO SEASON COMMENCEMENT** in accordance with his/her age group, Otherwise he/she will not be eligible to play in any organized competition by the club.

5. It is Compulsory for the parents to assist the club one day per season in the form of voluntary help. Also attending fundraising functions would be appreciated.
6. It is the committee of the Preston Lions JFC responsibility to allocate each player in the appropriate team.
7. The selection of the team shall be the duty of each team coach, and there will be no exception to the rule.
8. If a member has a grievance, it should be submitted to the junior co-ordinator in writing for assessment and resolution.
9. All associated members/players/parents/guardians of the club must obey the "Code of Behavior" of the sport they participate. In the event of misbehavior, members should be prepared to face the consequences and pay these fines. The club will not be responsible for fines incurred from F.F.V. (e.g. red card for foul behavior or swearing).
10. Any Member failing to comply with these rules will find themselves (at the discretion of the disciplinary committee) ejected or removed or as member of preston lions football club.

## **COACHES CODE OF BEHAVIOR.**

1. Any fines issued to a coach by the FFV to be paid by the coach.
2. Be reasonable in your demands on young players time, energy and enthusiasm.
3. Teach your players that rules of the sport are mutual agreements which no one should evade or break
4. Whenever possible, group players to give a reasonable chance of success.
5. Avoid over-playing the talented players. The 'Just-Average' players need and deserve equal time.
6. Remember that children participate for fun and enjoyment and that winning is only part of their motivation. Never ridicule or yell at the children for making mistakes or losing a competition.
7. Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of the players.
8. The scheduling and length of practice time and competition should take into consideration the maturity level of the children
9. Develop team respect for the ability of opponents as well as for the judgement of officials and opposing coaches.
10. Follow the advice of a physician when determining when an injured player is ready to recommence training or competition.
11. Make a personal commitment to keep yourself informed of sound coaching principles and the principles of growth and development of children.

## **PARENTS CODE OF BEHAVIOR**

1. Any fine/s issued to a parent from the FFV, to be paid by the parent.
2. If children are interested, encourage them to participate. However if a child is not willing, do not force him or her.
3. Focus upon the child's efforts and performance rather than the overall outcome of the event. This assists the child in setting realistic goals related to his/her ability by reducing the emphasis on winning.
4. Teach children that an honest effort is as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
5. Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
6. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
7. Remember children are involved in organising sports for enjoyment, not yours.
8. Remember that children learn best from examples. Applaud good plays by all teams.
9. If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the official's judgement and honesty in public. Remember that most officials give their time and effort for child's involvement.
10. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
11. Recognize the value and importance of volunteer coaches. They give of their time and resources to provide recreational activities for children and deserve your support.
12. All Parents must respect the decisions made by the Juniors Committee and not criticize or lobby against a decision.

## **SPECTATORS CODE OF BEHAVIOR**

1. Any fines issued to spectator from the FFV, to be paid by the spectator.
2. Children play organised sport for fun. They are not playing for entertainment of spectators only, nor are they miniature professionals.
3. Applaud good performances and efforts from each team. Congratulate all participants upon their performances regardless of the game outcome.
4. Respect the official's decision. If there is a disagreement, follow the appropriate procedure in order to question the decision and teach the children to do likewise.
5. Never ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during a competition. Positive comments are motivational.
6. Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials and players
7. Show respect for your teams opponents. Without them there would be no game.
8. Encourage players to follow the rules and the officials' decisions.
9. Demonstrate appropriate social behavior by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches and player
